

Minimum Wage



You must be paid for every hour you work, including work before and/or after your scheduled shift and time spent traveling during the workday.

As of December 31, 2017, these minimum wages apply:

Minimum Wages in New York City – Rate Schedule	12/31/17	12/31/18	12/31/19
Fast Food Employers			
Any number of workers	\$13.50	\$15.00	
All Other Employers			
10 or fewer workers	\$12.00	\$13.50	\$15.00
11 or more workers	\$13.00	\$15.00	

There are special rates for tipped workers.
